a Zero Waste Implementation Plan.


While achieving a zero waste district may



WHAT TO BRING TO DOLLAR DAYS

TECH


- Batteries, all kinds (tape tops and bottoms; bag large batteries)
- CDs, DVDs, floppy discs
- Video game discs
- Vinyl records

- Ink & toner cartridges
- Small electronics*



KITCHEN

- Food scraps
- Household cleaner packaging (spray triggers, pumps, detergent lids, etc)



- Brita and Pur brand filters, pitchers & packaging
- Energy bar wrappers*
- Drink pouches
- Baby food squeeze pouches, with or without caps
- Plastic lids*
- Cereal bags
- Corks

BATHROOM

- Beauty product packaging*
- Prescription pill bottles (lids on, labels off)
- Toothbrushes, empty toothpaste tubes, dental floss containers




SPORTS

- Shoes
- Yoga mats
- Tennis balls

GARAGE & SHED

- Fluorescent bulbs & CFLs
- Pellet stove bags (must be turned inside out and free of debris)
- Household paints & stains*
- Propane canisters
- Maple tubing (by appointment)
- Small metal (hardware, bottle caps, lids etc)
- Tires (\$2.50, \$3.00 if on rim; auto & small truck tires only)



HOUSEHOLD/OTHER

- Mercury thermostats & thermometers
- Glasses & sunglasses
- Books (hardcover & soft cover)
- Textiles
- Documents for shredding
- Packing materials
- Tape dispensers & cores
- Cigarette waste
- Credit cards/gift cards

* MORE DETAILS

We cannot accept any electronic items larger than a microwave. We accept hand-held electronics, chargers, small household appliances etc. E-waste (televi-sions, computers and com-puter peripherals) must be taken to an e-waste collec-tion site.

We accept interior and exterior architectural coatings in original con-tainers, but cannot take spray paints, auto or marine paints.

Beauty product packaging includes makeup containers, lotions bottles/tubes, chapstick tubes, deodorant containers, hair gel bottles/jars etc.

Plastic lids smaller than two inches or large lids without a recycling symbol will be col-lected during Dollar Days. Lids that are commonly recyclable in your regular recycling include yogurt/cottage cheese containers, hummus tubs, and deli takeout containers.

Energy bar wrappers are foil-lined wrappers from granola bars, protein bars, diet bars, Clif Bars, Larabars, etc. Please no candy/cookie wrappers.
